EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING INFORMATION

Early Voting allows all registered voters to cast their ballot prior to Election Day between Thursday, September 24 and Monday, November 2 by voting at pre-designated sites named by the County Clerk. Early Voters must be registered voters with a valid picture ID showing their current voter registration address. No excuse or reason is necessary to take advantage of Early Voting. Any vote cast during the Early Voting period is final and may not be revoked. Early Voters are NOT eligible to vote on Election Day. **Early voting** will be conducted at the County Clerk's office or by mail. The last day to apply for a mailed vote by mail ballot is Thursday, October 29. Any registered voter may apply for a vote by mail ballot without specifying a reason. Please note: County Offices will be closed on Monday, October 12th.
