How to Estimate Your Tax Bill

Look up or obtain your parcel number from the Perry County Assessor's Office (Monday-Friday 8am-4pm) or perryil.com and click on the [green](#) button for "PAY YOUR TAXES".

-If calling us at the Assessor's Office, ask for your assessment value, any exemptions, and tax rate.

-If looking online, go to the past years tax bill and look for your assessment value, exemptions, and tax rate.

Your total assessment value is approximately 1/3 of your Fair Market Value.

Subtract any Exemptions applied:

-General Homestead Exemption (Owner Occupied): up to \$6000

-Home Improvement Exemption: Amount Varies

-Senior Citizens Homestead Exemption: \$5000

-Senior Citizens Assessment Freeze (SAF): Amount Varies

-Returning Veterans Homestead Exemption: \$5000

-Disabled Persons Homestead Exemption: \$2000

-Disabled Veterans Standard Homestead Exemption: Varies, based upon disability rating

THIS WILL BE YOUR TAXABLE AMOUNT

Multiply your Taxable Amount by your Tax Rate to get your Estimated Tax Bill Amount

EXAMPLE: \$150,000 Market Value home with Owner Occupied Exemption

Market Value/3 = Assessment Value

Assessment Value-Exemptions = Taxable Amount

Taxable Amount x Tax Rate = Tax Bill Amount

$150,000/3 = 50,000 - 6,000 \times \text{Tax Rate } (0.097658) = \$4,296.95$

IMPORTANT: Once your tax bill is issued, it is too late to appeal your assessment.
